


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



05. ENTRY FEE - TYRES - ENGINE

TYRES

THREE sets of tyres per weekend for each car except at the first event of the Championship when FOUR sets will be allocated for each car.

Every driver will have TWO sets of tyres per collective test and the possibility to mark 2 more sets of used tyres. A set of tyres is used when the driver cross the pitlane line using them.

ENGINE

Each driver may use no more than TWO engines and THREE turbos for the entire Championship including the collective tests.

Should a driver use any further replacement engine(s) or turbo(s) a 10 or 5 grid places penalty respectively will be imposed to him/her for the next race he/she takes part.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee per car per season is 15,000€ including 7 racing weekend events and 6 collective test days.

Wild card fee is 3,500€ and test is not included.


